or
Passed ("zachtено" or "зачтено")
Not passed ("ne zachtено" or "не зачтено")

The lowest passing grade is Satisfactory and Passed. Students are only permitted to enroll in the next year of study and to be awarded a diploma if they have passing grades in each subject of the curriculum.
